



# Supported Living System

Group home settings provide an intensive, structured milieu for individuals who require a high level of support and assistance on a 24 hour basis. Individuals require moderate to maximum assistance for ADLs and functional mobility. Individuals may require medical interventions and assistance with issues including bowel/bladder routines, skin integrity and swallowing. On average, individuals in this setting receive 1 hour of Physical Therapy, and Psych treatment monthly, and 0.5 hours of Occupational and Speech Therapies monthly. A highly structured routine provides the individual with opportunities to practice the skills necessary to support their continued rehabilitation, functional stability and to participate in a stable activity plan.

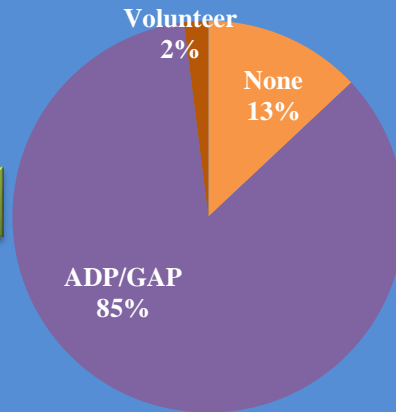

### Medical House Vocational / Avocational Status

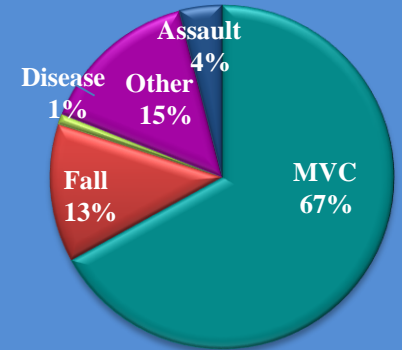


## Program Demographics

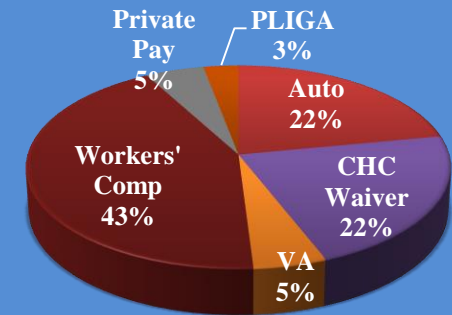

### Medical/Rehab Nursing Support and Care Coordination

Physiatry and Neuropsychiatry (Paoli only) provide weekly on-site visits. Medical Director & Neuropsychiatrist on-call 24 hours/day.

NP available as needed for medical issues. Rehabilitation Case Manager full-time; Physician and Nursing oversight provided; RN and clinical on-call services 24 hours/day. Psychology available for psychiatric crisis/suicidality.

### Therapy Services

Clinical Specialist skilled in Physical Rehabilitation. Available therapies include PRN PT, OT, Speech, Psychology, Therapeutic Recreation, Drug & Alcohol Counseling, and Cognitive Rehabilitation. Music and Art Therapies available in Paoli programs. Vocational Services available. Therapists assist individuals in the development and maintenance of physical skills, coping and communication skills, leisure planning and participation in productive activities. Therapists available as needed for therapy on-site, in the clinic and as a consultant to the team. Groups available on site.

## Staffing & Services

### Staffing

Staffing ratios of 1:2 including 1:1 staffing as needed. Serves individuals with High Acuity as determined by 6+ hours of direct care per day on average. Staff skilled in rehabilitation and medical treatments including: transfers, transfer aids, pulmonary aids, bladder/bowel routines, complex medication administration, vital signs monitoring, exercise routines, dysphagia management, advanced brain injury rehabilitation. CBIS certified staff. Overnight supervision and assistance provided to include assistance for turning and incontinence issues as needed. Individuals are assisted with transportation. Wheelchair vans on site.
