

NeuroBehavioral/NeuroRehab System

Long-term supported living settings provide an intensively staffed and structured environment for individuals who demonstrate problematic behaviors of a low frequency and low to moderate intensity. Treatment focuses on the utilization of compensatory strategies to manage behavior, increase the individual's awareness, communication and coping skills, and develop a stable activity plan. On average, current individuals in this setting receive .5 hours of Physical Therapy monthly and .5 hours of Psych treatment weekly.


Stable Activity Plan:

- 81% of individuals participate in vocational/cognitive activities an avg. of 14.1 hrs. a week (includes supported employment, volunteering, school and attending the Adult Day Program/ Group Activities Program)
- 95% of individuals participate in meaningful leisure activities an avg. of 70.8 hrs. a week (includes social, physical, creative expression, spectator appreciation and community involvement activities)



Medical/Rehab Nursing Support and Care Coordination

Physiatry and Neuropsychiatry provide weekly on-site visits. Medical Director & Neuropsychiatry on-call 24 hours/day.

NP available as needed for medical issues. Rehabilitation Case Manager full-time; Physician and Nursing oversight provided; RN/clinical oncall services 24 hours/day.

Psychology available for urgent psychiatric crisis/suicidality.

Staffing & Services

Therapy Services

Clinical Specialist skilled in brain injury rehabilitation and behavioral programming. Available therapies include PRN: Behavior Analysis, PT, OT, Speech, Psychology, Drug & Alcohol counseling, Therapeutic Recreation, Music & Art Therapies, and Vocational Services.

Therapists assist the individual with behavior management, coping and communication skills. TRs support participation in productive activities and access to the community. Therapists available on site or as a consultant to the team.

Groups on site.

Staffing

Staffing ratios of 1:3; staffing able to increase quickly in response to behavioral/mood changes. Serves individuals with Moderate to High Acuity.

Staff skilled in: behavioral techniques and data collection, CPI (crisis prevention) certification, advanced brain injury rehabilitation skills. CBIS certified staff.
