

# Home and Community Services

Home & Community Services in New Jersey provide a continuum of treatment from comprehensive evaluation to intensive rehab. Services are provided primarily in the individual's home, the community and the work setting to support generalization of skills and a meaningful recovery. Treatment specialties include cognitive rehabilitation, psychology, and vocational services. Services are typically provided up to five days a week during business hours (8:30-5).

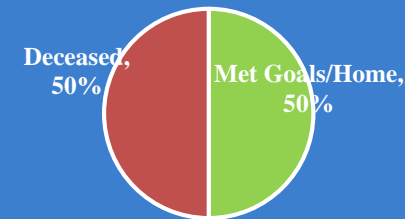

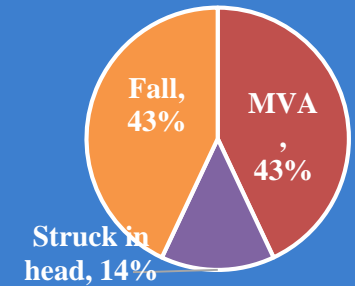
## Funding Sources

## Comprehensive Therapy Program:

The Comprehensive Therapy Program consists of 3-5 days per week of services. The program combines services in the clinic, structured home, and community. Therapies include physical, speech/language and occupational therapies, psychology, and therapeutic recreation. These are delivered through individual therapy, group therapy and staff support implementation of strategies in both the home and community settings. Psychiatry and neuropsychiatry are also offered. Services focus on the development of systems and strategies necessary to support medical and mood stability and to maximize optimal participation in life roles in the community and at home.

## Services

## Individual Therapy Program:

Traditional individual therapy services which are offered include: speech/language, occupational therapy, physical therapy, cognitive rehabilitation therapy, psychology and therapeutic recreation. Often individuals with mild brain injury are referred for individual therapy services targeting development of compensatory cognitive strategies, psychology, and return to work services.
